The 14-day average COVID positive rate in Floyd County has been above 10% for three consecutive days and continues to trend up. Per the board approved decision making matrix, approved October 12th, and recommendation from the Public Health Department, the superintendent recommends moving grades 7-12 into hybrid learning effective Tuesday, November 10 to Tuesday November 24.
