Transportation

Charles City Community Schools operates propane, diesel, and gas school buses traveling 1,000 miles and transporting approximately over 600 students daily. Our buses are maintained and operated by qualified and caring school bus drivers, and transportation staff with the highest regard for the safety of our students. The department also operates activity buses providing transportation for school athletics and field trips.

Iowa Law states (1) Elementary pupils shall be entitled to transportation only if they live more than two miles from the school designated for attendance. (2) High school pupils shall be entitled to transportation only if they live more than three miles from the school designated for attendance.

All of the buses are equipped with a Camera Monitoring System and the No Child Left Behind Alarm for the safety of our students and drivers.

This year we will be implementing a new system on our buses. Our new passes will track students getting on and off the bus by scanning their bus pass. Therefore, they will need their passes in order to ride. Your child will need their bus pass by Sept. 7 and after that they will not be able to get on the bus. Parents should contact the Transportation office after Aug. 1 (641-257-6590) for Transportation needs.
