### POTENTIAL SOLUTION

After carefully reviewing community feedback and financial impacts, the School Board is considering a possible solution known as “Revitalize.” It would include:



- Significant upgrades to safety & security
- 21st century learning spaces to enhance the educational environment
- Revitalization of outdated circles & special needs area
- Addition of an 800-seat auditorium

The proposed auditorium and a new secured entrance would be combined, filtering through the existing office. Part of the plan is designed to rethink the circles, taking out the inner walls and leaving the columns in place. This would create connections between the classrooms and resource areas.

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
