(Page 8 of Return to Learn Plan for more details)</li> <li>School cafeteria times/locations modified to ensure social distancing and allow for cleaning protocols.</li> <li>District will establish cleaning/sanitizing protocols based on CDC/IDPH guidelines.</li> <li>Transportations services will be prioritized for state-required routes.</li> <li>Co/Extra-curricular activities will be based on current guidelines from governing bodies.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Students in grades PK-4 will attend school in person daily.</li> <li>Students in grades 5-8 will be assigned to attend school in person on either M/Tu or Th/F, participating in required remote learning the other three days of the week.</li> <li>Students in grades 9-12 will attend on campus classes in cohort groups. Grades 9 and 11 will attend in person on M/Tu. Grades 10 and 12 will attend in person on Th/Fr. The remaining three days of the week will be required remote learning for both cohorts.</li> <li>The district MAY utilize Wednesday to provide in-person support to students with IEPs, 504s, ELL needs, etc.</li> <li>District will implement various mitigation and physical distancing protocols to reduce the spread of COVID-19.
